

The Portable Cabin

International design & architecture competition



This document includes information to register and the necessary procedures to participate in the competition. This will conclude in an exhibition of the best works presented on the IAC's website (www.ia-competitions.com) and in various important sites of design and architecture.

The Portable Cabin symbolizes a post Covid freedom and also a changing world of people moving around the globe for geopolitical reasons. A home that functions as a carry on to explore alternate ways of living.

New habits, new reasons, and a new context demands a new type of home.



Architectural Program

The architectural program is a guide to the elements of the project, the final dimensions are up to the contestant. They are the minimum requirements, new ones can be added, and they will be valued, as long as the minimum and maximum total area is respected. The exterior expansion spaces will not be computed within this surface, galleries, stairs, and so on.

Minimum Bathroom Space	Shower Sink Toilet
Minimum Save Space	1550m²
Minimum Desktop Space	2325m²

^{*}Spaces can be combined

The cabins covered area shouldn't be less than 15 square meters or 161 square feets or more than 50 m2 (538 square feets). The maximum height of the building will be 6 meters.



Participants

The contest is aimed at the entire global community of young architects and architecture students. In case of setting up work teams, designate a member of this as the only valid representative and interlocutor before the organizers in case of obtaining any prize.

The representative will be the one who has the corresponding prize, and will not be responsibility of the organizers how they will distribute the award.

There cannot be teams of more than 5 people, including the representative.

- Gold Honorable Mention + Exposure in our Media and Dissemination in the Main architectural sites.
- Silver Honorable Mention + Exposure in our Media and Diffusion in the Main architectural sites.

Registration

Delivery requirements

The delivery consist of 2 images: (A and B) in horizontal format, identifying only with the Registration KEY (it will be delivered to each team once we receive the registration certificate). The presentation technique will be absolutely free.

Images

Concept: Sketch, diagrams or graphics explaining the project concept and operational options.

Plant or plants: Showing the entire project and its site

Perspectives: Exterior views of the complex.

Construction: Explanatory development of the construction system.

Sustainability: Sustainable proposal of the prototype

Digital images require the next features

Digital image format: JPG.

Name: The file name must match with the registration Number, for example: 048b.jpg

Size: 8 Megabytes maximum per image.

Dimensions: horizontal (19.2inx 14.2in).

Participants must upload the files to our website: https://www.ia-competitions.com/submit-proposal. The file name must match the Registration Number (for example: 048b.zip).

Evaluation process

The jury will evaluate the projects based on the fulfillment of the objectives established in pages 2, 3 and 4 of this briefing.

It will value both creativity and representation techniques.

The jury is free to add other criteria that they consider important for the creation of the clinic.

A total of 25 proposals will be chosen that will go to the final round. From the 25 finalists, the jury will choose the winner, second and third place, in addition to the 4 honorable mentions.

Said elections will be based on the fulfillment of the objectives and the evaluation criteria.

Content to Send

Participants must present two (2) A1 format (594x841 mm or 23.4x33.1 inches) oriented vertically or horizontally with the registration number in the lower right corner.

The content of the panel is free, while the idea that the participants want to convey is clearly expressed.

In addition, one (1) description of the project that does not exceed 400 words must be submitted. The description must be delivered in PDF format and their name must only be the participant's registration number (eg 460418125.pdf).

The materials must be delivered in the Submit section on the IAC website.
